### FILINGS IN THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL'S OFFICE:

**Notice of Proposed Rules:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed with the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Game, Fish and Parks:** (February 7, 2018) intends to amend rules to create a 400 yard area as a no wake zone in front of campsites in Hughes County public water safety zones; create a no wake zone in the west boat ramp bay on Shadehill Reservoir; limit hunting in Oakwood Lakes State Park to shotguns using shells, crossbows, and bows; rename the administrative chapter from Black Hills Bighorn Sheep Hunting Season to Bighorn Sheep Hunting Season and make appropriate name changes to applicable rules; and eliminate the ability to harvest one muskellunge or northern-muskellunge, turning the species into a catch and release fish. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 32-3A-1, 41-2-18, and 41-17-1.1.

A public hearing will be held at the RedRossa Convention Center, 808 West Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on March 1, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. CT. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the office of the Secretary of the Department
