1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish the initial procedures for election to river basin
2 district councils in the 2018 general election.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 Each river basin district shall have a council consisting of six council members. Two council
6 members shall be elected from each subdistrict. To be eligible each council member shall be a
7 registered voter in the subdistrict for which they are seeking election.

8 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

9 The initial council members shall be elected at the 2018 general election.

10 Section 3. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

11 Before the 2018 election, each county auditor shall give notice of each district council
12 position for which nominating petitions may be filed in that county. Notice shall be published
13 in all official newspapers at least once a week for two consecutive weeks. The last publication
14 may not be less than ten nor more than fifteen days before the deadline for filing of nominating
15 petitions.

16 Section 4. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:



1 Nominating petitions shall be made available at the Office of the Secretary of State and each
2 county auditor's office on a form prescribed by the State Board of Elections. A member shall
3 be nominated by a petition signed by at least twenty-five registered voters of the subdistrict area
4 to be represented by the candidate. No candidate for the initial election may begin circulating
5 petitions for signatures until January 1, 2018.

6 A candidate seeking election to a council shall submit a nominating petition to the secretary
7 of state by five p.m. on July 1, 2018. A petition shall be considered filed if the petition is mailed
8 by registered mail by five p.m. on July 1, 2018.

9 The initial council members from each subdistrict shall be elected to serve staggered terms.
10 One member shall be elected to serve a four-year term and the second member shall be elected
11 to serve a two-year term. A candidate shall declare at the time the candidate submits a
12 nominating petition if the candidate is seeking the two-year term position or the four-year term
13 position.

14 Section 5. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

15 Any person who is a registered voter of the subdistrict is eligible to vote in an election for
16 the subdistrict.

17 Section 6. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

18 If no candidate receives a majority of the vote in the general election then the council
19 position shall be filled by the candidate who receives the most votes.

20 Section 7. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

21 A council member shall take office on the second Tuesday in January of 2019. Before
22 assuming the duties of office, all council members shall take an official oath pursuant to § 3-1-5
23 and execute an official bond. The official bond shall be in an amount not less than one thousand
24 dollars. Each official bond shall comply with chapter 3-5. The cost of an official bond may be

1 paid by the district.
