Letter of Intent Regarding USD Law School Budget Approved in the 2018 Session

Dear Board of Regents Executive Director, USD President Sheila Gestring, and the Law School Dean:

This Letter of Intent sets forth a particular view held by the Joint Committee on Appropriations (JCA) in approving your appropriation in the 2018 legislative session. As such, this Letter of Intent seeks to supplement the appropriation with specific policy guidance as approved on June 12, 2018.

While the guideline does not have the direct force of statutory law, it rests solidly on a long-standing tradition of Legislative-Executive relationships in South Dakota and it will be used by the Joint Committee as a basis for the fiscal oversight of your agency and its continued funding.

The 2018 Legislature approved \$300,000 in new general funds and transferred \$300,000 in general funds from the USD main campus to the USD Law School for fiscal year 2019 to improve the sustainability of the USD Law School. As part of this ongoing funding the JCA requests a report delivered no later than December 1 of each year, beginning December 1, 2019 addressing, at a minimum, the following items:

- Median LSAT scores for admitted students
- South Dakota bar passage rate
- Comparison of the South Dakota bar passage rate for USD Law School graduates and out of state law school graduates
- Class size
- Internships
 - Number of students by class participating and location
- Offerings of specialized curriculum
 - Number of graduates, areas of focus, and location
- How has adding 3 FTE (Director of Admissions, Admissions Counselor, and Career Services) enhanced learning at the USD Law School?
- How has adding the expanded curriculum coursework and 2 FTE (Director of Sioux Falls Experiential Learning and Sioux Falls Adjuncts) enhanced learning at the USD Law School and meet the needs of law graduate employers?

In order to maintain the full ongoing funding, the JCA recommends the following 2-year and 4-year goals for the USD Law School:

2-Year Goals (Incoming Fall 2020 class)

- SD Bar Passage Rate of 70% or greater
- Median LSAT score of 149 or higher
- Median UGPA of 3.4 or higher

4-Year Goals (Incoming Fall 2022 class)

- SD Bar Passage Rate of 80% or greater
- Median LSAT score of 151 or higher
- Median UGPA of 3.5 or higher

By achieving and maintaining these goals, the JCA believes the USD Law School will become sustainable and thrive in future years.

RE: Comment on the Letter of Intent Regarding USD Law Budget Approved in the 2018 Session

Dear Representative Anderson and Senator Tidemann:

Thank you for the draft letter of intent (LOI) regarding the USD Law budget dated March 26, 2018. The University of South Dakota and the Law School sincerely appreciate the support received from the Joint Committee on Appropriations (JCA) on efforts to strengthen South Dakota's Law School. The additional funding will allow for efforts we believe will have a significant and lasting impact on student success at the Law School and will translate to higher bar passage rates.

We appreciate the JCA's desire for metrics to measure the progress of our efforts and respectfully submit the following revisions for your consideration:

Annual Report to the JCA

Beginning November 1, 2019, and annually thereafter through November 1, 2023, the Law School will provide to the JCA a report containing:

- Class size for most recent incoming class
- Median LSAT for most recent incoming class
- Median Undergraduate GPA (UGPA) for most recent incoming class
- South Dakota Bar passage information for most recent graduating class
- Update on new efforts, their progress or outcomes, and future plans

2-Year Goals

- For the Fall 2020 incoming class:
 - Median LSAT score of 148
 - Median UGPA of 3.2
- For the graduating class that started in Fall 2017:
 - South Dakota Bar passage rate of 65% for first-time takers

3-Year Goals

- For the Fall 2021 incoming class:
 - Median LSAT of 149
 - Median UGPA of 3.2
- For the graduating class that started in Fall 2018:
 - South Dakota Bar passage rate of 70% for first-time takers

5-Year Goals

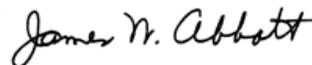
- For the Fall 2023 incoming class:
 - Median LSAT of 150
 - Median UGPA of 3.25
- For the graduating class that started in Fall 2020:
 - South Dakota Bar passage rate of 75% for first-time takers

We would be happy to discuss any of the proposed metrics, including their rationale. Thank you for the opportunity to provide our comments regarding the draft Letter of Intent.

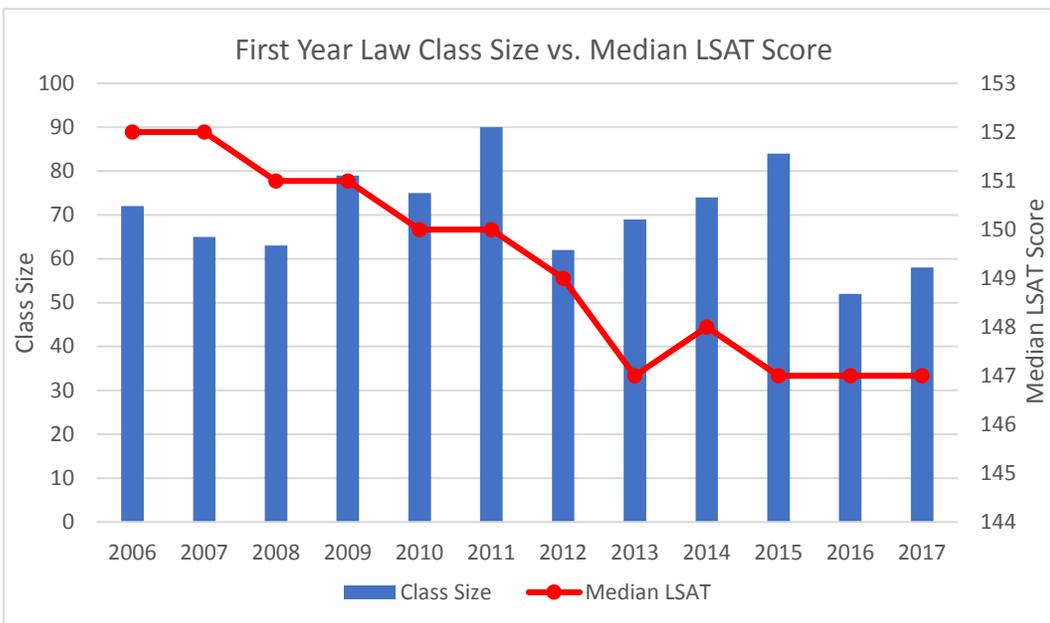

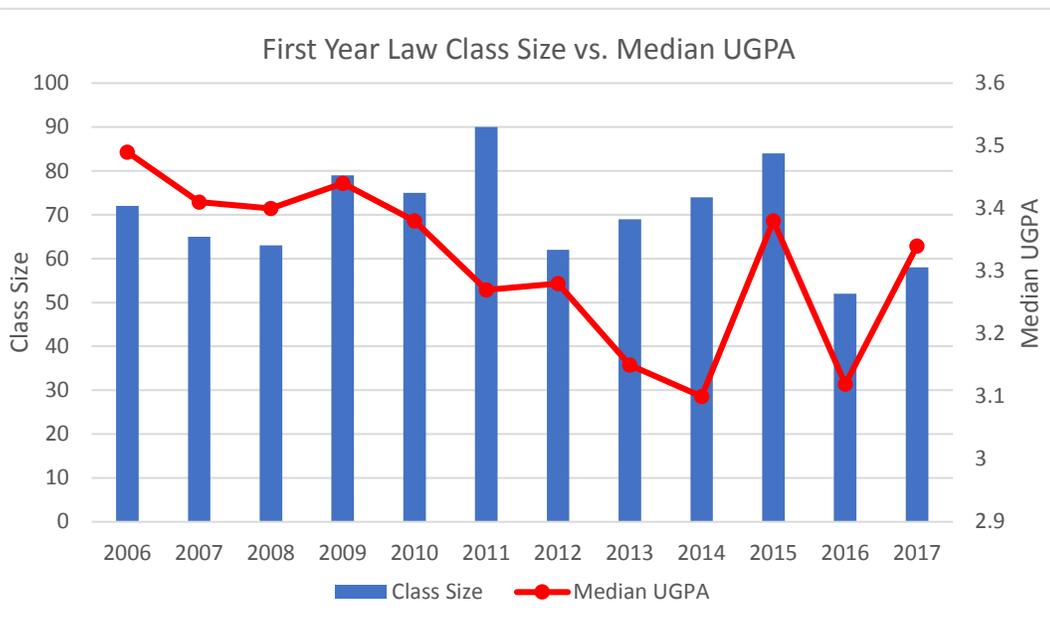

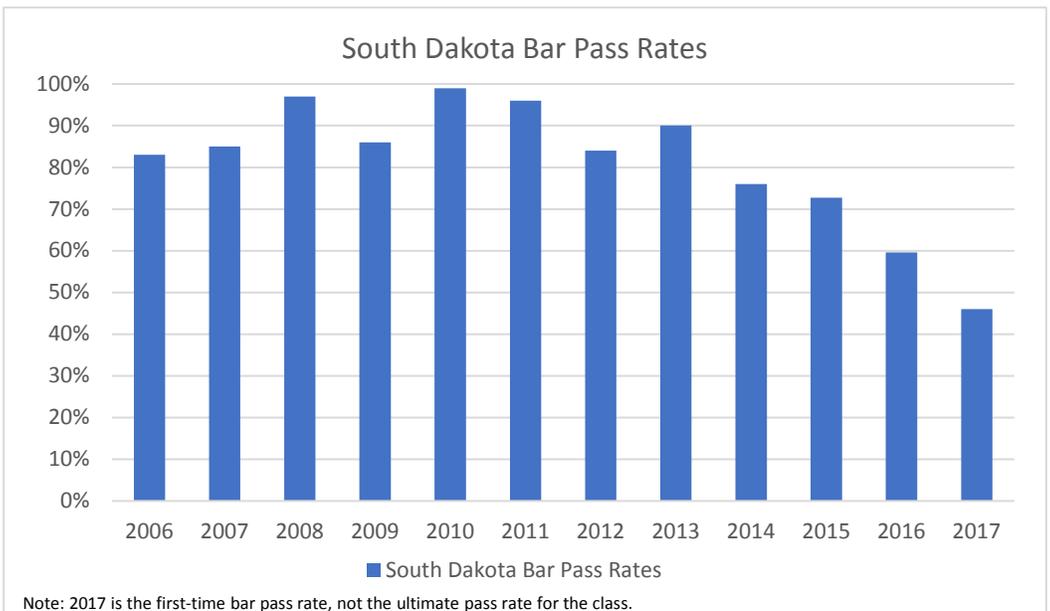
