1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain disclosures when selling labor law posters
2 to employers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Any person offering to sell any poster to any employer for the purpose of the
5 employer's compliance with any state or federal labor law notice requirements shall include a
6 statement that the offering is an advertisement. If the offering is sent by postal mail, the outside
7 of the offering and the front page of the enclosed material shall conspicuously include, in no less
8 than sixteen point font, the term, advertisement. If the offering is sent by electronic mail and is
9 not otherwise subject to subdivision 37-24-6(13), the subject line shall include the term,
10 advertisement, and the body of the electronic mail message shall conspicuously include, in no
11 less than sixteen point font, the term, advertisement.
