## HOUSE BILL NO. 1151

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow citizens without free access to a local library to  
2 borrow books directly from any library in the state.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 14-1-44 be amended to read as follows:

5 14-1-44. The State Library Office shall be responsible for executing the library policy of the  
6 State of South Dakota and shall:

7 (1) Promote adequate library service for all the people of the state;

8 (2) Supplement the services of libraries throughout the state;

9 (3) Increase the proficiency of library personnel through provision of in-service and  
10 continuing education programs for library personnel employed in the state;

11 (4) Provide for the citizens of the state specialized library services and materials not  
12 generally appropriate, economical, or available in other libraries of the state;

13 (5) Provide for the citizens of this state who do not have free access to a local library the  
14 opportunity to borrow books directly from any library in the state at no charge



1           through the interlibrary loan program of the South Dakota Library Network;

2        ~~(6)~~    Coordinate the libraries maintained by the executive department of state government

3            within the governmental complex in Pierre;

4        ~~(6)~~~~(7)~~ Establish and operate a state publications library distribution center; and

5        ~~(7)~~~~(8)~~ Collect and publish annual statistical data of libraries in the state.
