## HOUSE BILL NO. 1210

Introduced by: Representatives Street, Burg, Feickert, Hunhoff (Bernie), Lucas, Olson (Ryan), Pitts, and Rounds and Senators Peterson, Abdallah, Nesselhuf, and Turbak Berry

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions of administrative rules that  
2 establish the mileage allowance for the use of privately owned motor vehicles by state  
3 employees.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That ARSD 5:01:02:01 be amended to read as follows:

6 5:01:02:01. Allowance for use of privately owned motor vehicle. In lieu of actual  
7 transportation expenses, an employee shall be paid 37 cents a mile for use of a privately owned  
8 motor vehicle on official business outside the city limits of the employee's designated post of  
9 duty. The mileage rate covers all expenses incidental to the operation of a motor vehicle,  
10 including gasoline, oil, tires, repairs, towing, and insurance.

11 If State Fleet and Travel Management or Department of Transportation pool motor vehicles  
12 are available in a designated city but the employee desires to drive a personal motor vehicle, the  
13 employee shall be paid at the rate of ~~20~~ 30 cents a mile.

14 Upon written request of the head of a state agency or institution, an employee may be



- 1 reimbursed for mileage within a designated city area by the state auditor if the required travel
- 2 is not compensated through the employee's salary.
