## SENATE BILL NO. 193

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the  
Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year  
2 2012 and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The funds in section 5 of this Act are provided for the purpose of making a one-  
5 time payment to active, permanent employees hired on or before September 24, 2011, not  
6 including the Governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor,  
7 state treasurer, commissioner of school and public lands, or public utilities commissioners, for  
8 the purpose of encouraging public service and for continued service in the state government  
9 workforce. This payment will be made on March 30, 2012, and will be calculated as five percent  
10 of the employees' annualized salary effective as of March 23, 2012.

11 Section 2. For the purposes of this Act, annualized salary means an employee's hourly wage  
12 times the number of hours in the fiscal year in which the payment is made times the percent of  
13 time the employee is regularly scheduled to work, or the employee's annual salary times the  
14 percent of time the employee is regularly scheduled to work.

15 Section 3. Any payment pursuant to this Act is not to be considered as part of the employee's



1 base compensation or regular rate of pay, nor is the payment compensation for any past  
2 performance or future action.

3 Section 4. The amount necessary to fund the one-time payment to employees may be  
4 transferred to the appropriate budget units by the Bureau of Finance and Management. If there  
5 is not enough funding to provide the required payments to the workforce in place at the time of  
6 calculation, the bureau may reduce and prorate the amount of the one-time payments.

7 Section 5. That section 17 of chapter 23 of the 2011 Session Laws be amended to read as  
8 follows:

9 BUREAU OF FINANCE AND MANAGEMENT

10 (17) delete "State Government Energy Program" and insert "Employee Compensation"

11 Personal Services, General Funds, delete "\$0" and insert "\$12,296,256"

12 Personal Services, Federal Funds, delete "\$0" and insert "\$5,692,174"

13 Personal Services, Other Funds, delete "\$0" and insert "\$13,210,064"

14 Operating Expenses, General Funds, delete "\$0" and insert "\$193,023"

15 Adjust all totals accordingly.

16 Section 6. The commissioner of the Bureau of Finance and Management shall approve  
17 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

18 Section 7. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
19 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
20 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
