1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions pertaining to snowmobile
2 operation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-20A-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-20A-1. Terms used in this chapter mean:

6 (1) "Highway," as it is defined by subdivisions 31-1-5(1) to (4);

7 (2) "Law enforcement officer," as it is defined by § 23-3-27;

8 (3) "Operate," to control the operation of a snowmobile;

9 (4) "Operator," every person who operates or who is in actual physical control of a
10 snowmobile;

11 (5) "Owner," any person, other than a lien holder, having the property in or title to a
12 snowmobile and entitled to the use or possession thereof;

13 (6) "Raceway facility," any area designated and clearly defined with appropriate flags,
14 fencing, markers, or delineators for the purpose of drag racing, oval racing, or special
15 exhibitions;



1 (7) "Roadway," as it is defined by subdivision 32-14-1(26);

2 (8) "Snowmobile," any engine-driven vehicle of a type which uses sled type runners,
3 ~~wheels~~, or skis with an endless belt tread or similar means of contact with the surface
4 upon which it is operated and the vehicle does not exceed forty-eight inches in width;

5 (9) "Super modified snowmobile," any snowmobile which has been individually built
6 from parts expressly for track racing or has had the chassis, suspension, track, and
7 engine substantially altered.

8 Section 2. That chapter 32-20A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read
9 as follows:

10 Any resident owner who has titled a motorcycle which has been modified to comply with
11 the definition of a snowmobile for use as a snowmobile on a state snowmobile trail or area
12 established pursuant to the provisions of chapter 41-19 may purchase an annual permit valid
13 from December first to March thirty-first, inclusive, for a fee of twenty dollars. The permit shall
14 be affixed to the motorcycle on the right side of the unit and shall be clearly visible. The
15 Department of Game, Fish and Parks shall collect the annual permit fee imposed by this section
16 and shall deposit the fees in the snowmobile trails fund established by § 32-5-9.2.
