SENATE BILL NO. 241

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for an invasive species research
2 project conducted by South Dakota State University.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of three hundred
5 thousand dollars (\$300,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
6 Agriculture to provide for the engineering design, preconstruction activities, and construction
7 of a wetlands filtration system to treat contamination by invasive species at McCook Lake in
8 Union County. The department shall work with South Dakota State University's cooperative fish
9 and wildlife unit to conduct an invasive species research project in conjunction with the
10 wetlands filtration system.

11 Section 2. The secretary of agriculture shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
12 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

13 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
14 June 30, 2014, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
