MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1164* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 619) revise certain provisions regarding school board opening day decision petitions.
- HB 1249* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 569) revise the required hours in a school term for certain grade levels.
- HB 1213* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 620) analyze and promote economic development for South Dakota's Native American population and to establish a task force.
- HB 1206* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 625) authorize the payment of lease rental obligations to the South Dakota Building Authority by the Bureau of Finance and Management and to make an appropriation therefor.
- HB 1203* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 585) improve the financial practices of the State of South Dakota.
- HB 1194* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 583) establish certain requirements relating to the crossings of railroad rights-of-way by utilities.
- HB 1122* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 570) define the limitations of interstate compacts relating to the collection of civil fines.
- HB 1111* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 627, 628) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs and to make an appropriation therefor.

- HB 1041* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 545) make an appropriation for the railroad trust fund and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1142* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 547) enhance the support for public postsecondary technical institutes, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1175* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 623) authorize the Board of Regents to expand university facilities at the University of South Dakota, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1112* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 507) appropriate general funds and higher education facility funds to replace a portion of the other funds appropriated for the construction of swine teaching and research facilities at South Dakota State University and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1040* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 581) revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2014.
