## HOUSE TRANSPORTATION ENGROSSED NO. **HB 1020** - 01/22/2015

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the mailing fees for noncommercial vehicle plates  
2 and decals.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-5-82 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-5-82. On receipt of any application ~~under~~ pursuant to the provisions of §§ 32-5-2 and 32-  
6 5-3, the department or county treasurer shall deliver to the owner two number plates or two  
7 number stickers, or both. The plates or stickers shall bear the distinctive number contained in  
8 the application as mentioned in § 32-5-81. The applicant may request the county treasurer to  
9 mail that the plates or stickers for a fee as set forth in § 32-5-127. If the applicant requests that  
10 the plates or stickers be express mailed, the applicant shall pay the actual costs of postage and  
11 handling. All fees received by the county treasurer for mailing or expressing of the plates or  
12 stickers shall be deposited by the treasurer in the county general fund be mailed to the applicant.  
13 If the plates or stickers are mailed, a fee may be applied pursuant to the provisions of § 32-5-  
14 127.



1 Section 2. That § 32-5-127 be amended to read as follows:

2 32-5-127. In addition to the registration fees required by this chapter, the ~~department or~~  
3 county treasurer shall collect from the owner one dollar per ~~decal sticker~~ or set of ~~decals stickers~~  
4 and five dollars per license plate or set of plates, including any necessary stickers for the plate  
5 or plates, when ~~decals stickers~~ and plates are sent to the owner through the mail. If the owner  
6 requests the county treasurer to send the plates or stickers by express mail, the owner shall pay  
7 the actual costs of postage and handling. Any fee received by the county treasurer pursuant to  
8 this section shall be deposited by the treasurer in the county general fund.

9 If the plates or stickers are mailed to the owner by the department, the owner shall pay the  
10 actual costs of postage and handling. The department shall deposit in the state motor vehicle  
11 fund any fee received by the department pursuant to this section.
