1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to limit who may request to see a person's hunting or
2 fishing license.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 41-6-63 be amended to read as follows:

5 41-6-63. A licensee shall ~~at any time upon request of any person~~ exhibit the licensee's
6 license or other form of license authorization issued by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks
7 pursuant to Titles 41 and 42. ~~During the required license exhibition and~~ upon request by a
8 conservation officer or other law enforcement officer, a licensee who is sixteen years of age
9 or older who holds the other form of license authorization, shall exhibit and provide for
10 inspection a driver's license, a state-issued identification card, or another form of valid
11 identification for the purpose of verifying the identity of the licensee. Failure to exhibit the
12 licensee's license or other form of license authorization required by this section is a Class 2
13 misdemeanor.

14 Section 2. That chapter 41-9 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as



1 follows:

2 Any person who is hunting, fishing, or trapping or is engaged in any recreational activity
3 upon private land shall upon request exhibit the person's license to hunt, fish, or trap, or if
4 unlicensed or engaged in another recreational activity, shall provide the person's first name, last
5 name, town or city of residence, and state or province of residence as shown on the person's
6 driver license, state-issued identification card, or other form of valid identification for the
7 purpose of verifying the person's identity to any person who has legal authority to control access
8 to the private land where the hunting, fishing, trapping, or other recreational activity is
9 occurring. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
