MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HCR 1004 (HJ 9th LD; Deferred from 10th LD) Addressed to the United States Supreme Court setting forth certain facts and expressly enumerating the grievances of the People of the State of South Dakota, through their elected representatives, with that Court's decision in Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973), and its progeny and calling for that Court to now protect the intrinsic, natural, fundamental rights of the children of our State and nation and the intrinsic, natural, fundamental rights of their pregnant mothers in their relationship with their children, and the mothers' health by reconsidering and overturning the court's decision in Roe.
- HCR 1005 (HJ 11th LD) Urging Congress to propose the regulation freedom amendment to the United States Constitution.
- SCR 1 (SJ 9th LD) Commending the improvements to health care in South Dakota achieved by the system of care established by the community-based Mission: Lifeline initiative.
