SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1073 (Deferred from 14th LD) require a sex offender to report a change in vehicle status to law enforcement.

HB 1080 (Deferred from 14th LD) authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.

HB 1050 (Deferred from 14th LD) repeal certain funds, to make revisions to receipts dedicated to the property tax reduction fund, and to create the general revenue replacement fund.

HB 1098 (Deferred from 14th LD) authorize extended terms of lease for airport facilities.

HB 1111 (Deferred from 14th LD) increase the costs and expenses considered reasonable for the collection of certain dishonored checks.

HB 1120 (Deferred from 14th LD) revise the provisions related to phase in rate plans for plant additions and to declare an emergency.

- HB 1005 (Deferred from 14th LD) repeal the foundation program fund and references thereto.
- HB 1097 (Deferred from 14th LD) provide for a reduced minimum fall enrollment for certain school districts.
- HB 1117 (Deferred from 14th LD) provide for the approval of postsecondary courses for certain nonpublic school students and students receiving alternative instruction.
- HB 1095 (Deferred from 14th LD) provide access to abandoned cemeteries and private burying grounds.
- HB 1002* make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue to provide for the electronic submission of reports and taxes related to alcoholic beverages and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1047* revise certain reversion provisions relating to the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2013.
- HB 1092* establish the rural school teacher recruitment assistance program, and to make an appropriation to the education enhancement trust fund to provide for the annual funding of the program.
- HB 1083* require reimbursement to certain entities for fire suppression and extinguishment costs.
- HB 1124* authorize motor vehicles to exceed the posted speed limit under certain conditions.
- HB 1130 prohibit an abortion provider from accepting payment for an abortion prior to the end of the required informed consent period.

- SB 61 (Deferred from 14th LD) place certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency.
- SB 34* (Deferred from 14th LD) revise certain provisions concerning the administration of benefits provided to veterans and to declare an emergency.
- SB 14* (Deferred from 14th LD) provide for the possession and administration of opioid antagonists by first responders for the treatment of drug overdoses.
- SB 15 (Deferred from 14th LD) allow for discretionary appeals of illegal sentences.
- SB 18* establish certain administrative provisions regarding charitable raffles, lotteries, and bingo and to make violations of these provisions subject to the Deceptive Trade Practice and Consumer Protection Act.
