HB 1128* protect certain homestead exemption interests during sale of homestead or separation of owners.
HB 1134 revise certain provisions concerning the expungement of arrest records.
HB 1013* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions related to social work licensure.
HB 1080* (Deferred from 28th LD) authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.
HB 1058* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions regarding contagious disease control quarantine measures.
HB 1059* (Deferred from 28th LD) allow authorized entities to access immunization information in certain circumstances.
HB 1145 (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the payment of salary and compensation to legislators.
