## HOUSE BILL NO. 1183

Introduced by: Representative Johns and Senator Rusch

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the jurisdiction of  
2 magistrate courts to issue protection orders.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 16-12B-13 be amended to read:

5 16-12B-13. A magistrate court with a magistrate judge presiding has concurrent jurisdiction  
6 with the circuit courts to try and determine all civil actions, if the debt, damage, claim, or value  
7 of the property involved does not exceed twelve thousand dollars. A magistrate court with a  
8 magistrate judge presiding has concurrent jurisdiction with the circuit courts to try and  
9 determine any action for a protective or restraining order or injunctive relief pursuant to chapter  
10 22-19A, 21-8, or 25-10 or § 15-6-65. Any magistrate court with a magistrate judge presiding  
11 has jurisdiction in small claims proceedings, if the debt, damage, claim, or value of the property  
12 involved does not exceed twelve thousand dollars.
