SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 32 codify legislation enacted in 2015.  
SB 37 adopt the 2015 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code.  
SB 40 revise signature and seal requirements for the Board of Technical Professions.  
SB 41 revise certain provisions related to the Board of Technical Professions.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1005\* (JR 5-17 with pending amendment; HJ 185) revise and repeal certain fees that are established to compensate counties for services provided by county officials.  
HB 1069 (Deferred from 11<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions related to genetic counselor licensure.  
HB 1066\* revise certain provisions regarding the public notice for a meeting of a public body.  
HB 1065 designate the Civilian Conservation Corps Museum of South Dakota in Hill City as the official Civilian Conservation Corps Museum of South Dakota.  
HB 1078 grant limited immunity from arrest and prosecution for certain alcohol related offenses to persons who assist a person in need of emergency assistance or who are themselves in need of emergency assistance.

HB 1016 revise the authority granted to the Building Authority and to the Board of Regents to construct certain improvements at South Dakota State University in Brookings and the University of South Dakota in Vermillion.
