HCR 1005\* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 246) Urging the federal government to refrain from enacting regulations that threaten the reliability and affordability of electric power in the northern great plains.

HCR 1012 (HJ 18<sup>th</sup> LD) Requesting the South Dakota congressional delegation to introduce legislation to compensate private landowners for fire damage caused by the United States Forest Service.

- HB 1208 (Removed from Consent Calendar) provide for the sale of certain surplus real estate at the South Dakota Developmental Center and to provide for the deposit of the proceeds.
- HB 1187 (Removed from Consent Calendar) allow the Office of the Secretary of State to refuse to file certain documents.
- HB 1064\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) apply certain penalties regarding damages, tampering, and malicious acts to certain railroads that carry passengers.
- HB 1202 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) provide access to abandoned cemeteries and private burying grounds
- HB 1080 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation and to transfer certain money to the Bureau of Administration to fund a design study for a potential expansion and upgrade to the State Animal Disease Research and Diagnostic Laboratory and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1135 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) establish venue for certain actions arising out of real property lease agreements.
- HB 1157\* require that a doctor provide a woman additional information as a part of informed consent prior to performing an abortion.
- HB 1136\* ~~revise certain provisions regarding the annual report provided by the Board of Regents to the Council on Higher Education Policy Goals, Performance, and Accountability, and to declare an emergency.~~  
eliminate the Council on Higher Education Policy Goals, Performance, and Accountability and to transfer its functions to the Legislative Planning Committee.
- HB 1169\* allow a school district to operate an attendance center within another school district.
- HB 1182 increase the state sales tax, the state use tax, the excise tax on farm machinery, and amusement device tax for the purpose of increasing education funding and reducing property taxes, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1110 provide medical care for certain unborn children.

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 10 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the renovation and construction of an addition to Harding Hall on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- SB 11 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to purchase land from the Dakota State University Foundation for the use and benefit of Dakota State University in Madison, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 17 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency.
- SB 18 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.

- SB 68 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) make appropriations from the water and environment fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes, to revise solid waste management program recycling provisions, to revise water and environment fund loan terms, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 27 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain personnel requirements for ambulance services and to repeal the hardship exemption.
- SB 28 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) require meningococcal immunization for school entry.
- SB 2\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 12\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to sell certain extraneous real property in Brookings County and to deposit the proceeds with the state treasurer to be credited to a fund designated as the real property acquisition and capital improvement fund for South Dakota State University.
- SB 13 establish a new retirement benefit structure for certain public employees who are members of the South Dakota Retirement System.
- SB 15 revise certain provisions concerning the membership of the South Dakota Investment Council.
