House Page Resolution 3

HB 1182 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by which Lost) increase the state sales tax, the state use tax, the excise tax on farm machinery, and amusement device tax for the purpose of increasing education funding and reducing property taxes, and to declare an emergency.

SB 52 establish procedures for reporting federal tax changes for purposes of the bank franchise tax.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1206* (Deferred from 23rd LD) authorize the use of handguns in the hunting of game birds.
HB 1209 (Deferred from 23rd LD) require any public body of the state to accept as valid all information on a person's birth certificate.

- HB 1047* make an appropriation for the payment of extraordinary litigation expenses and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1161* provide for and regulate consumer lines of credit and to provide a penalty for certain violations.
- HB 1132* require the submission of sexual assault kits for testing.
- HB 1133* require that a risk assessment is completed and reviewed before the release of a person charged with certain domestic crimes.
- HB 1167* revise certain provisions regarding the use of a suspended imposition of sentence for a misdemeanor and a felony.
- HB 1243* prohibit the unauthorized sharing of certain private images on the internet.
- HB 1198 recognize dyslexia as a learning disability.

- SB 8* (Removed from Consent Calendar; HR 7-1) revise certain provisions regarding background investigations for prospective employees of the postsecondary technical institutes and to transfer certain funds regarding postsecondary technical credentialing.
- SB 2* (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 34 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions regarding the chemical testing of commercial drivers.
- SB 120* (Deferred from 23rd LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians, dentists, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- SB 63* (Deferred from 23rd LD) require the development of school safety plans and to require the conduct of school safety drills in accredited schools.
- SB 114 make an appropriation for certain costs related to the commissioning of the USS South Dakota and to declare an emergency.
- SB 53* revise certain provisions concerning the bank franchise tax.
- SB 59 revise certain provisions regarding the application of the special annual road funding levy.
