- HB 1208* (Deferred from 26th LD) provide for the sale of certain surplus real estate at the South Dakota Developmental Center and to provide for the deposit of the proceeds.
- HB 1024 (Deferred from 26th LD) make an appropriation for the maintenance and repair of state owned dams and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1007* (Deferred from 26th LD) make an appropriation to revise and update the data and methods used to determine the agricultural land production capacity and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1201* (Deferred from 26th LD) revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2016, make an appropriation for teen court programs in South Dakota, and to declare an emergency.
