HB 1141* license persons offering applied behavior analysis services to the public.

HB 1182* increase the state sales tax, the state use tax, the excise tax on farm machinery, and amusement device tax for the purpose of increasing education funding and reducing property taxes, to provide for certain school district reporting and penalties, and to declare an emergency.

HB 1080 make an appropriation and to transfer certain money to the Bureau of Administration to fund a design study for a potential expansion and upgrade to the State Animal Disease Research and Diagnostic Laboratory and to declare an emergency.

HB 1213 create the new frontiers program to support innovative research by South Dakota companies.
