MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 1015 (HJ p 660) Commending Taiwan's presidential election; supporting Taiwan's efforts to secure entry to the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) and the signing of the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) and the Bilateral Investment Agreement (BIA) with the United States; and reaffirming support for increasing Taiwan's international profile and for strengthening and expanding sister-state ties between South Dakota and Taiwan.

HCR 1017 (HJ p 662) Commending the nation of Israel for its cordial and mutually beneficial relationship with the United States and with the State of South Dakota.

HB 1177\*        revise certain provisions concerning tax incentives for certain energy facilities.

HB 1204\*        ~~provide a sales tax exemption for certain nonprofit corporations created for the  
purpose of fire protection.~~

the purpose of fire protection.

HB 1079\*        permit the prescription and possession of an opioid antagonist in certain instances.
