1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require schools to provide instruction in hands-only
2 cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-3-91 be amended to read:

5 13-3-91. The secretary of education shall ~~annually~~ identify cardiopulmonary resuscitation
6 (CPR) ~~as a recommended skill~~ skills that all schools ~~should~~ shall include within required school
7 ~~health~~ curriculum and shall inform school districts of resources and training available to assist
8 schools to provide instruction in CPR and the use of automated external defibrillators.

9 Section 2. That chapter 13-33 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

10 To provide the instruction required in section 1 of this Act, the school board or governing
11 body shall use either of the following:

12 (1) An instructional program developed by the American Heart Association or the
13 American Red Cross; or



1 (2) An instructional program that is nationally recognized and based on the most current
2 American Heart Association guidelines for CPR and emergency cardiovascular care.

3 The psychomotor skills necessary to perform hands-only CPR and awareness in the use of
4 an AED shall be incorporated into the instruction.

5 For the purposes of this section, the term, psychomotor skills, means the use of hands-on
6 practicing to support cognitive learning.

7 Section 3. That chapter 13-33 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

8 A certified teacher is not required to be an authorized CPR or AED instructor to facilitate,
9 provide, or oversee the instruction required in section 2 of this Act. However, any CPR course
10 that results in the students earning a CPR course completion card shall be taught by an
11 authorized CPR or AED instructor.

12 Section 4. That chapter 13-33 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

13 The Department of Education shall annually conduct a survey of each applicable school to
14 determine compliance with the requirements of this Act.
