Executive Appointment:

Marli Wiese, District 8, was appointed on January 26, 2017, to the **South Dakota House**, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Representative Mathew Wollmann on January 23rd. This appointment is effective January 31, 2017.

Executive Order:

The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2017-03**, dated January 23, 2017. Under the authority of SDCL Chapter 34-48A, Emergency Management law, the Order declares a state of emergency and disaster to exist in the South Dakota counties of Butte, Clark, Codington, Day, Deuel, Dewey, Edmunds, Fall River, Faulk, Grant, Haakon, Hamlin, Harding,

Jackson, Jones, Marshall, McPherson, Meade, Pennington, Perkins, Roberts, Stanley, Sully, and Ziebach, the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe within Dewey and Ziebach counties, and the Oglala Sioux Tribe within Jackson County; for three months from the date of this executive order unless further extended by a subsequent executive order, due to the severe winter storm from December 24 through December 26, 2016. Federal resources are needed to help alleviate the impacts of the severe winter storm to state, tribal and local governments.
