3-22-2017	<b>Department of Revenue: SD Commission on Gaming</b> Amend Racing rules to clarify the penalty for use of illegal substances, repeal 20:04:27:13 to allow therapeutic medication to be used, allow the use and administration of furosemide, clarify the use of certain therapeutic medications, allow the Commission and stewards to impose penalties which may be considered by other racing jurisdictions and allow the Commission and stewards to consider a trainer's pattern of drug or medication violations in other jurisdictions when determining a penalty for violations in South Dakota; 43 SDR 119, February 27, 2017.
3-24-2017	<b>Department of Revenue: South Dakota Lottery Commission</b> Adopt rules to authorize and establish the parameters to offer the Lucky for Life game; 43 SDR 123, March 6, 2017.
4-10-2017	<b>Department of Health: Board of Massage Therapy</b> Amend rules relating to applications, temporary permits and inactive licenses, clarify the educational requirements for licensure or a temporary permit, increase the fees for an initial license, renewed license, inactive license and temporary permit, clarify the time period of a continuing education cycle and a licensee's continuing education requirements and recordkeeping requirements, repeal unnecessary rules regarding the board's complaint process, clarify the malpractice insurance requirements of a licensee or temporary permit holder and recordkeeping requirements, clarify the requirements for requesting an inactive license, and updating the list of facilities recognized by the board to provide the education necessary to meet the requirements for licensure; 43 SDR 109, February 6, 2017.
