Notice:

The **Department of Social Services** intends to make the following changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan clinic services and specialized surgical hospitals payment methodologies effective April 4, 2017. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) clarifies clinic services and specialized surgical hospitals payment methodologies. The SPA amends page 5 of Attachment 4.19-A and page 15 of Attachment 4.19-B of the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan. The Department estimates there will be no federal fiscal impact associated with this SPA in Federal Fiscal Year 2017 and Federal Fiscal Year 2018.
