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**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Attorney General: Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Training Commission:**

(June 10, 2003) intends to adopt a rule to authorize a law enforcement agency to compensate a reserve officer when the reserve officer is assigned duties to replace a full or part-time officer who has been called to active military duty and the period of active military duty exceeds or will exceed thirty consecutive days. The general authority for this rule, as cited by the commission, is SDCL 23-3-35.

A public hearing will be held in the RoI Kebabach Criminal Justice Training Center, Classroom 1, Pierre, South Dakota, on August 21, 2003, at 10:00 a.m. A copy of the proposed rule may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Training Commission, Division of Criminal Investigation, c/o Kim Knecht, 500 E. Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by the close of business on August 18, 2003. **Department of Game, Fish and Parks:**

(June 16, 2003) has filed rules to establish the number and types of antelope licenses and tags available in the applicable and renumbered hunting units; establish the number and types of licenses and tags available in the applicable and renumbered East River deer hunting units; modify (extend by seven days – December 1, 2003, though December 7, 2003, inclusive) the

hunting season dates in all East River deer hunting units to those licensees who possess any type of a valid and unfilled antlerless deer license or tag; beginning December 1, 2003, any unused and/or unsold "any deer" license or tag shall be converted to an "any antlerless deer" license or tag, "any whitetail deer" license or tag is converted to an "any antlerless whitetail deer" license or tag, and "any mule deer" license or tag is converted to an "any antlerless mule deer" license or tag to be valid for the extended hunting season (December 1 through December 7, inclusive) and the reopened hunting season (January 1, 2004, through January 11, 2004, inclusive); and to reopen the hunting season on certain property in the applicable hunting units from January 1 through January 11, 2004, inclusive, only for those licensees who possess any type of a valid and unfilled 2003 antlerless deer license or tag in the applicable hunting unit; modify the hunting season dates and length of the hunting seasons in certain units and make modifications to the areas contained within certain hunting units for the Early Fall Canada Goose hunting season; modify the period of time during which applications for new shooting preserves and renewal applications for existing shooting preserves must be received in Pierre to no later than March 1 and repeal the provision concerning the earliest time that a renewal application may be submitted to the department; establish waterfowl refuges on Lake Oahe: Dry Creek State Waterfowl Refuge, Okobojo Creek, and at the Whitlock Bay area and establish their respective boundaries; modify when traps and snares are required to be checked by a trapper; upon request require testing of the breaking strength of snares; require free operation of the swivel device on a snare; prohibit statewide the

use of snares on all public land and within any improved road rights-of-way during certain periods of time; establish prohibitions, requirements, and procedures of persons whose traps have caught or captured a wild animal in their traps after the established season is closed; require trappers to render their traps and snares inoperable during certain periods of time; and require removal of all traps and snares from all public land and improved road rights-of-way at a certain time; and adopt and implement procedures relating to issuance, revocation, and refusal to issue a taxidermist license and specimen record keeping and tagging requirements. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 41-2-18, 41-6-10, 41-6-21, 41-6-33, 41-8-20, and 41-11-5.

A public hearing will be held at the Ramkota RiverCentre in Pierre, South Dakota, on July 10, 2003, at 2:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to John L.
