REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED

7-16-2009	Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Minerals and Environment	Update the state's existing hazardous waste rules by incorporating updated federal regulations by reference. These updates reflect changes made to the federal hazardous waste rules from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. Changes include amending existing requirements for recycling; clarification of compliance monitoring requirements for hazardous waste combustion operations; and amending requirements for the management of wastewater treatment sludges generated by automobile assembly operations; 35 SDR 352.
7-16-2009	Education: Board of Education	Amend a Special Education rule to clarify student due process procedures; amend a

		Funding rule to comply with federal mandates for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and Individual with Disabilities Act (IDEA) in transferring of special education funds to another fund to carry out activities authorized under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965; amend Certification rules to allow teachers or special education paraprofessionals with one year of teaching experience to be granted the special education endorsement; and allow individuals with the National School Counselor Certification to receive stipends, as do Nationally Board Certified teachers, if money is appropriated; and amend General State Aid rules to clarify what a full course load for a secondary student consists of and what constitutes a full-time student; 35 SDR 311.
7-21-2009	Health: Board of Funeral Service	Amend rules to increase fees for renewal and applications, clarify the educational requirements for licensure, and eliminate outdated requirements on caskets displayed in the selection room; 35 SDR 317.
7-23-2009	Transportation	Amend a speed zone in Meade County on South Dakota Highway 79 north of Sturgis to reduce the speed limits on a segment of highway north of Highway 34 during the first two weeks of August; 36 SDR 1.
