Department of Labor: Public Utilities

Commission: (September 30, 2005) intends to amend rules to set forth the requirements for filing an application for a permit to construct wind energy facilities and amend some requirements applying to the siting of energy conversion and transmission facilities. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the commission, is SDCL 49-41B-35.
