NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council)

Department of Social Services: (November 15, 2002) has proposed a rule amendment according to SDCL 1-36-20. The amendment terminates eligibility of individuals (Q1-2s) whose income is between 135 and 175 percent of the federal poverty level. This group receives limited assistance with the payment of their Medicare Part B premiums.

The state of South Dakota is mandated to adhere to this as a condition of participation in the Title XIX (Medicaid) program. This amendment

must be implemented no later than December 31, 2002.
