NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council)

Department of Game, Fish and Parks: (November 20, 2002) intends to adopt rules that modify the time when a park entrance license is not required at Custer State Park by repealing the park entrance license exemption for the day before the fall buffalo roundup, add and amend fish limits for inland waters and special management waters concerning Lynn Lake and Middle Lynn Lake in Day County, and implement procedures relating to the issuance, revocation, and refusal to issue a taxidermist license and record keeping requirements, customer specimen record requirements, prohibitions, responsibilities, date of implementation, and licensing procedures of taxidermists and their customers. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 41-2-18, 41-6-10, 41-6-33, 41-17-1.1, and 41-17-13.4.

A public hearing will be held at the Cedar Shores Resort in Oacoma, South Dakota, on December 12, 2002, at 2:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to John L. Cooper, Secretary, Foss Building, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received prior to the hearing date. Department of Commerce And Regulation: Division of Insurance: (November 22, 2002) intends to adopt rules that clarify when care provided by family members can be covered by long-term care insurance, provide a means for individual health policy premiums to be reviewed on a less rigid schedule, and to clarify who the requirements regarding creditable coverage and pre-existing waiting periods apply to. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, are SDCL 58-4-1, 58-17-30.2, 58-17-87, 58-17B-4, and 58-17B-15.

A public hearing will be held in the First Floor Conference Room of the Commerce Building, 118 West Capitol Avenue, in Pierre, South Dakota, on December 18, 2002, at 9:00 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to the South Dakota Division of Insurance, 118 W. Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by December 27, 2002, to be considered. Copies of the rules are also available on the Division's web-site located at: www.state.sd.us/dcr/insurance. Persons who have special needs for which the Division can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-3563 before the hearing.

Department of Social Services: Office of Medical Services: (November 22, 2002) intends to adopt rules that allow the department to establish a state MAC list for certain drugs. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 28-6-1.

A public hearing will be held in Conference Room #1, Kneip Office Building, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on Wednesday, December 18, 2002, at 1:15 p.m.

Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to Jill Wellhouse, Administrative Rules, Department of Social Services, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be postmarked by December 28, 2002 and received by December 30, 2002, to be considered. Individuals intending to present oral testimony at the hearing must make a written copy of their testimony available to the Department at the time of the hearing. The written and oral comments must relate directly to the changes being proposed and must cite the specific rule number to which the comments are being directed. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
