List of Statutory Legislative Committees (scope, statute)

Executive Board (SDCL 2-9): Considers legislative policies between sessions, investigate, collect information on government general welfare, recommend action, including proposed legislation on important issues, create and appoint study committees, etc.

Bonding Committee (SDCL 2-6-14): Review operations, programs and financial status of bonding authorities.

Rules Review Committee (1-26-1.1): Review proposed agency rules, hear public testimony, recommend rule changes, propose legislative changes to administrative law.

Retirement Laws (SDCL 2-6-8): Study pension and annuity and benefit laws for employees/officers in public service.

State-Tribal (SDCL 2-6-20): Study relations between the state and its political subdivisions and the tribes and tribal governments.

Water Development oversight Committee (SDCL 2-6-19): Monitor meetings and actions of Board of Water and Natural Resources and the Water Management Board.

Agland Assessment Task Force (SDCL 10-6-33.35): Review the implementation of law concerning the assessment and taxation of agricultural land and review rules and propose legislation.

Special Joint Appropriations Committee (SDCL 4-8A-2): release funds appropriated for contingent purposes, review, evaluate, and coordinate state fiscal and budgetary policy, carry out assignments made by Executive Board.

Government Operations and Audit Committee (SDCL 2-6-2): Review operations and fiscal affairs of state government, review findings of abuse or neglect in juvenile corrections facility.
