## SENATE BILL NO. 71

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Bureau of Finance and Management

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation from the coordinated soil and  
2 water conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the coordinated soil and water conservation  
5 fund the sum of one million two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,275,000) to the State  
6 Conservation Commission for the purpose of providing grants to aid, assist, and cooperate in  
7 cropland, grassland, timberland, and water quality improvement projects identified through  
8 community resource/hydrologic unit plans.

9 Section 2. The State Conservation Commission shall approve vouchers and the state auditor  
10 shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

11 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
12 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
