## HOUSE BILL NO. 1035

Introduced by: The Committee on State Affairs at the request of the Department of Commerce  
and Regulation

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the minimum age at which a person may  
2 contribute to a horse or dog race.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 42-7-76 be amended to read as follows:

5 42-7-76. The certificate system ~~shall expressly authorize~~ authorizes the right of a licensee to  
6 collect and receive contributions of money from any person ~~eighteen~~ twenty-one years or older  
7 toward the entry of any horse or dog in ~~such a~~ the race selected by ~~such the~~ the person to run first in the  
8 race; ~~and the~~ The person contributing ~~such the~~ the money ~~shall acquire~~ acquires an interest in the  
9 total money contributed on all horses and dogs in the race as first winner in proportion to the  
10 amount of money contributed by ~~such the~~ the person. The licensee shall receive ~~such the~~ the  
11 contributions of money and issue to the contributors thereof certificates on which shall be shown  
12 the number of the race, the amount contributed, and the number or name of the horse or dog  
13 selected by ~~such the~~ the person as first winner.
