SENATE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

ENGROSSED NO. **SB23** - 2/11/98

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to construct a performing  
2 arts center at South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the construction, completion, furnishing,  
5 equipping, and maintaining of the Performing Arts Center at South Dakota State University,  
6 Brookings, including utilities, furnishings, architectural and engineering services, and site  
7 preparation and the construction of sidewalks and driveways and landscaping the grounds of that  
8 facility, all at the estimated cost of ten million four hundred thousand dollars (\$10,400,000), to  
9 be paid from other funds under the control of the Board of Regents, from gifts and grants to  
10 South Dakota State University specifically for this purpose, including bond proceeds provided  
11 by the city of Brookings, and from financing provided pursuant to chapter 13-51A, all of which  
12 are hereby appropriated to the Board of Regents for the purposes of this Act.

13 Section 2. In addition to the funds in section 1 of this Act, the Board of Regents shall set  
14 aside the sum of one million forty thousand dollars (\$1,040,000) for the purpose of maintenance  
15 and repair of the facility authorized in section 1 of this Act to be paid from other funds under the

1 control of the Board of Regents, from gifts and grants to South Dakota State University,  
2 including bond proceeds provided by the city of Brookings.

3 Section 3. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for  
4 these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any other source, all of which shall  
5 be deemed appropriated to this construction and maintenance and repair.

6 Section 4. The design and construction of these modifications shall be under the general  
7 charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in chapter 5-14. The  
8 commissioner of the Bureau of Administration and the executive director of the Board of  
9 Regents shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures  
10 authorized by this Act.
