1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to specifically exempt lake sediment from certain state
2 mineral lease provisions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 5-7-2 be amended to read as follows:

5 5-7-2. It is hereby specifically provided that all leases for prospecting for, producing, and
6 marketing oil and gas, geothermal resources, bentonite, and gypsum, shall be, and for feldspar,
7 mica, coal, and all other minerals or combinations thereof, may be, issued after advertising and
8 sale at public auction to the highest bidder on oral bids. The sale of sand, gravel, rock, stone,
9 clay, shale, and lake sediment are specifically exempted from the provisions of this section.
