1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require a report in certain circumstances when an audit
2 finding reoccurs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 2-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 If an audit report of any department, institution, board, or agency of the state includes an
7 audit finding that also occurred in an immediately preceding year, the Government Operations
8 and Audit Committee may require the department, institution, board, or agency to present a
9 report, as part of its budget hearing, during the succeeding legislative session. The report to the
10 Appropriations Committees shall include the reasons for not implementing the audit
11 recommendations and a corrective action plan.
