1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain penalties against persons teaching in
2 nonpublic schools.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-42-2 be repealed.

5 ~~— 13-42-2. It is a petty offense for a person to teach in any nonpublic school in this state any~~
6 ~~of the courses prescribed to be taught in the schools of this state without being the holder of a~~
7 ~~certificate authorizing him to teach the courses in the public schools of this state. Each day this~~
8 ~~section is violated is a separate offense. A violation of this section is sufficient grounds for~~
9 ~~revocation by the secretary of the department of education and cultural affairs of any teacher's~~
10 ~~certificate held by a violator of this section. This section does not apply to persons providing~~
11 ~~alternative instruction as provided in § 13-27-3.~~
