1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to designate the prairie dog as a statewide declared pest.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 38-22-9 be amended to read as follows:

4 38-22-9. The South Dakota Weed and Pest Control Commission, pursuant to rules
5 promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 1-26, may determine which plants and
6 animals shall be considered to be weeds and pests and shall from time to time prepare, and the
7 Department of Agriculture shall publish, a list of state weeds and pests. The black-tailed prairie
8 dog is hereby designated as a declared statewide pest.

9 Section 2. That § 34A-8A-7 be repealed.

10 ~~34A-8A-7. Designation as a species of management concern abrogates any previous~~
11 ~~designation as a weed or pest.~~

12 Section 3. That ARSD 12:62:03:01.05 be amended to read as follows:

13 12:62:03:01.05. Declared pests. The following pests are declared pests statewide:

14 (1) Gypsy moth;

15 (2) Black-tailed prairie dog.
