1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to create South Dakota Achievement Days, and to make an
2 appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The term, South Dakota Achievement Days, as used in this Act means an
5 exhibition designed to promote education, and to encourage improvement in agriculture,
6 horticulture, livestock, poultry, dairy products, liberal arts, mechanical fabrics, fine arts,
7 domestic economy, and 4-H club activities by offering premiums and rewards for the best
8 exhibits.

9 Section 2. Starting in the summer of 2007, South Dakota State Fair and Achievement Days
10 shall be held at Huron.

11 Section 3. There is hereby annually appropriated from the state general fund the sum of two
12 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), or so much thereof that may be necessary, to the
13 Department of Agriculture as financial assistance to the governing board of the fair that will host
14 South Dakota State Fair and Achievement Days for that year. The money shall be used to
15 organize, operate, and promote South Dakota State Fair and Achievement Days.



1 Section 4. The secretary of the Department of Agriculture shall approve vouchers and the
2 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

3 Section 5. This Act is effective on July 1, 2007.
