## SENATE BILL NO. 82

Introduced by: Senators Adelstein, Dempster, Duniphan, Knudson, Olson (Ed), and Two Bulls and Representatives Hennies, Bradford, Hanks, McLaughlin, Putnam, and Valandra

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the appointment of a Native American law  
2 enforcement officer to the Law Enforcement Office Standards Commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 23-3-28 be amended to read as follows:

5 23-3-28. There is hereby created a Law Enforcement Officers Standards Commission in the  
6 Office of the Attorney General. ~~This commission shall consist of ten~~ The commission consists  
7 of eleven members, ~~seven~~ eight of whom shall be appointed by the attorney general as follows,  
8 to wit: one person from the Division of Highway Patrol; one person who is a duly elected,  
9 qualified, and acting sheriff of this state; one person who is a duly appointed, qualified, and  
10 acting member of a municipal police department of this state; one law enforcement officer who  
11 is an enrolled member of an Indian tribe; one person who is a member of the State Bar of South  
12 Dakota; one member recommended by the executive director of the Board of Regents; one  
13 member recommended by the South Dakota Municipal League; and one member recommended  
14 by the South Dakota County Commissioners Association. Three additional members are ex  
15 officio members as provided in § 23-3-30.



1       The attorney general on the first appointments shall appoint three such members for terms  
2 of one year and four such members for ~~a term~~ terms of two years; thereafter all such  
3 appointments ~~shall be~~ are for two years. ~~Any such appointee shall be eligible to succeed himself~~  
4 ~~in office.~~ Commission members are eligible for reappointment.
