1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Expressing support for the South Dakota coordinated
2 natural resources conservation plan.

3 WHEREAS, the Legislature is aware the state's natural resources are the foundation of our
4 area's quality of life and economic health; and

5 WHEREAS, while South Dakotans currently enjoy the benefits of our natural resources,
6 they are also responsible for ensuring that future generations have the same opportunities; and

7 WHEREAS, South Dakota's conservation districts and state conservation commission have
8 developed a joint coordinated plan that creates a framework of opportunity for all South
9 Dakotans to voluntarily participate in caring for our natural resources; and

10 WHEREAS, the coordinated plan for natural resources includes broad goals that promote
11 local flexibility to address natural resource priorities and objectives:

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Eighty-
13 second Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the South
14 Dakota Legislature supports the South Dakota coordinated plan for natural resources as a means
15 of ensuring the sustained conservation and wise use of the natural resources of the great state
