1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to impose a child support collection fee.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 25-7A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 Beginning January 1, 2008, the Department of Social Services shall retain a twenty-five
6 dollar annual fee from child support collections which exceed five hundred dollars in a calendar
7 year and are made on behalf of a person receiving support enforcement services from the
8 department and who has never received assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social
9 Security Act.

10 Section 2. That § 28-1-66 be repealed.

11 ~~— 28-1-66. The Department of Social Services shall make child support enforcement services~~
12 ~~available to an individual not otherwise eligible for those purposes upon application from an~~
13 ~~individual and payment of a reasonable fee. The department shall promulgate rules pursuant to~~
14 ~~chapter 1-26 to set the application fee and any fees imposed for collection services. However,~~
15 ~~the application fee shall be refunded to the applicant by the parent responsible for paying child~~



- 1 ~~support payments and the fees imposed for collection services shall be paid by the parent~~
- 2 ~~responsible for paying child support payments to the Department of Social Services.~~
